

What is NAMGAR?

The Register was established in 1975, with the sole objective of promoting the restoration, preservation and enjoyment of the MGAs, Magnettes and Variants. As of 2026, we have thousands of active members representing 10,000 registered cars. While NAMGAR was created to serve North American MGA enthusiasts, we now boast a worldwide membership with a dozen countries represented. NAMGAR is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors comprised of a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Treasurer, Registrar, and Communications Manager. These five key leaders are assisted by many other NAMGAR volunteers who bring the membership *MGA!* magazine, an active website plus national and regional events and activities.

Important information about registering

When you fill out the car data part of the NAMGAR Membership Form, your vehicle will be registered in the NAMGAR database, and you will receive a dash plaque with a registration number that will be permanently associated with that vehicle. The following information will assist you in providing NAMGAR with the data needed to make an accurate registration. If the car data is incomplete or inaccurate we will need to contact you for additional information before your registration can be completed.

Note: If you have been referred by a current NAMGAR member, please enter their name in the first part of the application.

Variant: An MGA Variant is defined as a vehicle manufactured between 1955 and 1962 which was supplied by the factory with an MGA drive train as original equipment.

If you share our passion for the MGA, Magnette, Elva, TVR, or other variants, join us and see how NAMGAR can enhance your classic car experience.

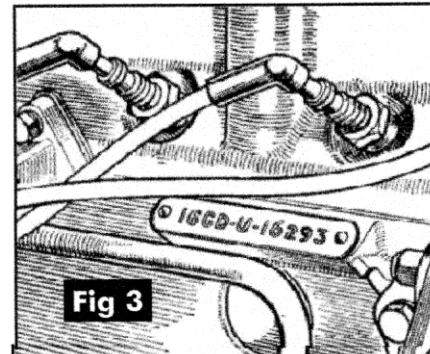
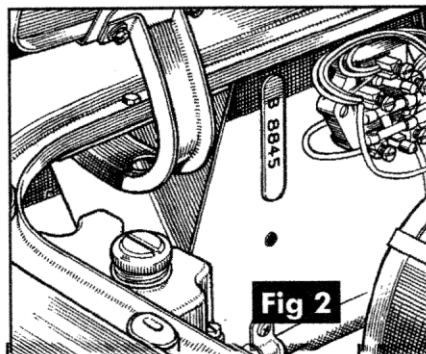
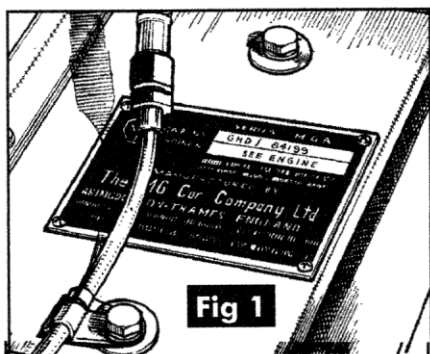
Chassis Number: The chassis number, or Vehicle Identification Number (VIN), is the primary identification used by NAMGAR to register your vehicle and is therefore the most critical piece of information. On MGAs, the chassis number is found on a plaque on the horizontal firewall in front of the heater core (Fig 1). On Z Magnettes, it's on the firewall near the fusebox. The chassis number may also be found on the title. If you cannot recover the chassis number, we will assign a "dummy" number.

For MGAs, chassis numbers normally begin with "H" for 1500 models, "GHNL" for 1600 models, "GHNL2" for Mk II models, and "Y" for Twin Cam models. The serial number will be between 10101 and 109070 for pushrod MGAs and 501 to 2611 for Twin Cams. Z Magnette chassis numbers begin with "KA" and the serial numbers run from 501 to 37101.

Body Number: An MGA's body number can be found on a plate on the vehicle firewall next to the right hand (passenger side) hood hinge (Fig 2). A Z Magnette body number is near the left hand hood hinge. The number is often painted over but should still be legible.

Engine Number: The pushrod engine number is on the right-hand side of the block below the 2nd and 3rd sparkplugs (Fig 3). The Twin Cam number is on a plate at the rear of the block. The plate is aluminum and may not have survived previous rebuilds. If the number is missing it may also be on the chassis number plaque for MGA 1500 models.

Parts Car Only: Check "Yes" if the vehicle has been wrecked, junked or is used only for parts and will not be restored. NAMGAR tracks these cars, but does not assign Register numbers or dash plaques.
